Introduction

God bless you super abundantly in the name of Jesus Christ, I would like to thank you for taking the time to listen to this three part CD teaching series of God's Word where you will learn some of the keys that Will release God's prosperity into your life as you apply the truth that you learn.

The Word of God is the Will of God, and the heart of God is for each of His children to prosper and be in good health, it has never been God's heart for His people to suffer lack or to suffer sickness.

So why are so many of God's people suffering sickness and disease? Why are many of God's children living in poverty? To find out these answers we must go to God's Word the bible, and see what God has to say.

Hosea 4:6 (King James Version of the Bible)

My people are destroyed for a lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

Here in Hosea it says my people, God is talking about his people they were being destroyed for a lack of knowledge. We have to ask ourselves a question here, what type of knowledge were Gods people lacking? It couldn't be a lack of knowledge of this world or what the world had to say, it has to be a lack of knowledge of God's Word.

It is the same story today, God's people are being destroyed because they lack a knowledge of what God has to say in their relationships, in their finance's, in their health, in their work places and their families and so on, but it does not have to be that way for you, and if it is that way for you, then I would urge you to start applying what God tells you from His word to do.

If you are willing to learn what God has to say and you are willing to apply and do what the Word of God tells you, to apply and do, you too can start living the way God wants you to live which is in peace and happiness and prosperity and health. You do not have to be destroyed for a lack of knowledge of what God's has to say, and God has plenty to say in how we live our lives. when we listen and do what God says from His Word we will then reap the blessings and benefits, of what God's Word says we can have for, and in our lives.

Jeremiah 2:13 (KJV)

For my people have committed two evils; they have forsaken me the fountain of living waters, and hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.

Again God says my people, the bible is about God's people and what God wants for His people, the bible is not written for unbelievers and God rejecters, it is written so that God's children can know what God wants for them and know how God wants them to live. So let's take a look at this verse, it says my people have committed two evils.

Number 1. They have forsaken me. The first thing that God's children have done was they forsook God, the word forsaken in verse 13 can also mean **refuse**, they refused God by choosing to do things in their own way; they refused to go to the fountain of living water. God says "He is a fountain of living waters". A fountain has an endless supply of water.

Number 2. God's people hewed or made cisterns, and they were broken cisterns that could hold no water, every time God's children went to their cistern to draw of the water, their supply would have leaked away, so when they wanted to have what they needed it was wasn't there. If they kept going to God for what they needed they would always have what they wanted, their needs would always get met. God said these two things were evil, forsaking or walking away from God, and then trying to meet their own needs.

You see God wants to take care of everything in your life; he wants you to go to him not forsake him, and then God wants you to leave things to Him, by trusting Him because whatever you need in your life, what ever area in your life the need is God can and will meet that need. When we go to him and ask and not try to sort it out ourselves.

Proverbs 3: 5-6 (KJV)

Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

God wants you to look only to Him in everything you do, Trusting in the Lord with all your heart, is looking only to God, and when God see you are going to him for answers and needs and wants when he see you acknowledge him first, then He can guide you and show you what you have to do.

111 John 2 (KJV)

Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

This is God's heart for you, right now. Today God wishes above all things that YOU, write your name there ----- may prosper, which means you have a good journey through life. God wants you to have a good journey through life.

When I am visiting overseas I take all the things I need for a good journey I make sure I have want I need and more, well this is God's heart and we are his children so God wants you to have the very best for your journey. The word prospers also means that you succeed in reaching your goal, and our true goal is to move God's word throughout all the inhabited parts of the World. This verse also goes on to say "and be in good health" the word health here means to have sound health and it also means to be safe and sound. And then the verse goes on to say even as thy soul prospereth. Prospering and to be in health according to God's word depends upon our soul prospering in sound knowledge of God's word living in our hearts. This word of God must be having success within our hearts.

Psalms 1: 1-6 (KJV)

Psalm 1

Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

2 but his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

4 The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away

5 Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

When God's Word is dwelling in us richly we are like that tree in Psalm 1:3

A tree that is planted by water has an endless supply, because the roots go right down into the ground, right to where it constantly receives what its needs and more to continue to produce fruit, when we have that Word deep in our hearts and living in our lives we too will show forth all the fruits of God's goodness to us.

John 10:10 (KJV)

The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

So Jesus said “he came that they”, lets ask ourselves a question here who are they? Those that believe, those that are called, and that includes you and me.

Jesus said “I am come that they might have life and that they might have it more abundantly”. The word might is in this verse twice, you see we have to apply in our lives what God’s word tells us to apply, so we can reap this abundant life.

If we are not manifesting this abundant life then we know the thief is at work in our life, so we need to see what God’s Word says we have to do, and apply it in our life. The word life in this verse means fullness of life it is available for you and me to live fullness of life and the Word abundant means super abundantly, wow so lets ask ourselves another question am I living the life that Jesus came to give and am I living the life that God wants me to live, or am I being destroyed through a lack of knowledge. Is the thief at work in my life?

Well if he is at work in my life and I am being destroyed through a lack of knowledge of God’s word, what do you think I should do? Well I will tell you what I would do. I would ask God to help me understand his word and ask Him to get me someone to help teach me.

See we have to come back to God and also God’s Word for our answers and continue in the Word of God.

11 Timothy 3: 14 – 17 (KJV)

But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them;

And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

Verse 16 and 17 are so important we see here that **ALL SCRIPTURE** is first given by God and secondly the scripture (which is God’s Word and given by Him) is Profitable for us to have a good journey through life, here is what the word is profitable for

1. **Doctrine**, which means how to believe the right way
2. **Reproof**, for when we are not believing the right way
3. **Correction**, which is back to believing the right way .

Verse 17 then says that the man (or woman or teenager or child) may be **perfect** (perfect means Complete), **Furnished** (furnished means equipped) with the word of God dwelling in us we are complete and equipped, isn't God great.
We have holy spirit in us which is Christ in Us and we are complete. (colossians 2:10).

So you see to manifest God's abundance in our lifes we have to come to God's Word. We find out what is available from God's word so then we can utilise and apply the Word of God in our lives and then we can get Gods results, we will see his abundance In every area that we live his Word. So my prayer is that you listen to the 3 CD's on Keys to releasing God's prosperity and as you make this teaching your own and apply it and do it, you will begin to manifest God's prosperity in you life.

James 1:22 (KJV)

But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

So lets not deceive our own selves by only hearing the Word of God, but lets manifest Gods abundance today by being doers of the Word, as we do this we bring all the glory to God.
